In Mangaldai UHC area, the Td 10 yrs. coverage has increased to 63% & Td 16 yrs. coverage has increased to 48% for the period of April'22 to March'23. Whereas earlier the coverage for Td 10 yrs. was 10% & Td 16 yrs. was 8%.
