Minutes of the District Development Committee meeting , Darrang held on 19-09-2022 at 11:00 A.M in the conference hall of DC's office, Darrang

The District Development Committee (DDC) meeting held today on the 19th September, 2022, with an aim to review the progress of ongoing schemes and programmes of the different departments and to resolve inter departmental issues. The meeting was chaired by Deputy Commissioner, Darrang. At the very outset, the Deputy Commissioner, Darrang welcomed all the members present at the meeting and initiated the meeting with the discussion on the action points of the last DDC meeting held on 30th August, 2022

Thereafter, Department wise following discussions held & resolution have been adopted accordingly

Henceforth, Inspector of school is directed to issue notification to schools for administering 2nd dose of vaccination 7) Joint director of health services is directed to organize publicity campaign regarding vaccination, since CVCs are operational in the district but no one is showing urgency to get the vaccine on time. 8) Door to door survey to be started for polio coverage and as on date of 19th September, 2022, 50% polio coverage has been completed in the district 9) Birth dose is being given both in Private and Govt.
